Bioscience of Health & Disease Graduate Training Program Award

Eligibility:

This Award was established by a generous donation from friends, families and colleagues in the Division of BioMedical Sciences. Valued at a portion of the income on the endowment, it will be awarded annually to a **full-time or part-time graduate student (M.Sc. or Ph.D.) in Bioscience of Health and Disease from the Division of BioMedical Sciences**. Preference will be given to full-time graduate student. The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for an award as defined by Memorial University of Newfoundland, and the Award will be based on cumulative accomplishments such as best quality research, project, or presentation.
