Please use the RGS [Faculty of Medicine – Scholarship Application Form](#) to avoid submitting duplicate components for each of the following scholarships/awards. You can complete the application form, check the awards you wish to apply for, and include one (1):

- cover letter
- CV with a list of appropriate publications and/or presentations
- transcript(s) – unofficial is acceptable
- a research statement with progress to date (or anticipated research goals if just starting your research)
- supervisor (or main advisor) reference letter

Should a scholarship/award require an extra component, it will be listed below under **Application Process** and should be clearly identified as a component of that particular application (for example: *reference letter #2 for Dr. Noreen Golfman Graduate Award*).

Dr. Anna C. Templeton Memorial Graduate Scholarship

Deadline: Wednesday, January 24th, 2024 (apply to rgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility:

Awarded annually to a **full-time graduate student** who has demonstrated leadership in either the **teaching of craft or home economics, promotion of craft or home economics, or the development of craft or home economics** in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador. This scholarship is not renewable but re-applications may be considered. The student must be from Newfoundland and Labrador or have lived in the province for 12 consecutive months while not enrolled in full-time studies at post-secondary institutions.

Application Process:

Students must submit a [Faculty of Medicine – Scholarship Application Form](#) to the Research & Graduate Studies (RGS) Office, Faculty of Medicine (rgs@mun.ca). Applications should also include (and be clearly identifiable in your application package):

- a one-to-two page statement demonstrating leadership in either the teaching of craft or home economics, promotion of craft or home economics, or the development of craft or home economics in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador
- a second letter of reference
