Faculty of Medicine Graduate Scholarship

Deadline: Wednesday, January 24th, 2024 (apply to rgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility:

The Faculty of Medicine Graduate Scholarship was established by a generous gift through *Dare To...The Campaign* for Memorial University. The Scholarship will be awarded to a **full-time graduate student in the first year of a two-year master's program in the Faculty of Medicine** and is valued at a portion of the income on the endowment.

Preference will be given to students with **research interests related to the study of autism**. Preference is also given to students interested in <u>remaining in NL after graduation</u> (though this is not required). To be eligible, students must have scholarship standing.
