- cover letter
- CV with a list of appropriate publications and/or presentations
- transcript(s) – unofficial is acceptable
- a research statement with progress to date (or anticipated research goals if just starting your research)
- supervisor (or main advisor) reference letter

Should a scholarship/award require an extra component, it will be listed below under **Application Process** and should be clearly identified as a component of that particular application (for example: *reference letter #2 for Dr. Noreen Golfman Graduate Award*).

Mrs. Bernice C. Finney Graduate Scholarship in Pediatrics

Deadline: Wednesday, January 24th, 2024 (apply to rgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility:

This scholarship, established in honour of Mrs. Bernice C. Finney, was created by her son Mr. Steve Finney. Bernice grew up in St. John's and with her husband Bill, moved to Torbay in 1965 where they raised six children. For many years, Bernice volunteered as a door-to-door canvasser for charities such as the Cancer Society, Heart and Stroke Foundation and the Red Cross, among others. Bernice has supported many causes over the years and her generosity is legendary in the family, as she never says no to those in need.

Awarded annually to a **full-time graduate student** in the Faculty of Medicine whose research supports the discipline of pediatrics, with a **preference for pediatric oncology**.

Application Process:
