Business Arising	 Phase 2 schedule update Juanita and David have been working on the schedule. The core content of the schedule will be completed before summer. Summative assessments for the medical expert will be completed before summer. Lisa will give an introduction to the students to Phase 2 on Monday, March 03. Clinical skills assessment will be similar to Phase 1 assessment. There will be a formative OSCE in June. Assessment Maps The assessment maps have to be available to the students no later than 1 week after the start of class. The assessment maps are currently in draft format. They need to be reviewed and revised. There will be four summative blocks. The students need 75% in at least 3 of the blocks and an overall average of at least 75%. 	

 If a student receives less than 75% then there will be reassessment. In a reassessment the highest mark is 75%, regardless of how much above 75% the mark is. Remediation: what are the issues, can we fix the issues, do we need to repeat something, and does the student need to complete some type of project to be promoted. A percentage of previous content will be assessed: Block 2, 5%; Block 3, 10%; Block 4, 15%. 	
 Community Engagement Assessment Map The Community Engagement Assessment map is similar to Phase 1. There is a handbook worth 40%. The pass mark is 75%. 	
 Special Projects Assessment Map Will have exact requirements. Due dates of assignments will be different than exam times. Still a work in progress. Link each component to details of that component. Attendance should be taken if participation is part of the mark. 	
 Independent Projects Include "participation marks" on d2l where needed. Some tutorials have poor attendance. Attendance may be poor if tutorials are scheduled close to an exam. According to MUN policy, attendance can only be taken if it involves safety or skills. 	
 PMLP Strategic Planning is an online module. Leading versus Managing is a four hour session. 	

	 Gerona McGrath – Evaluation Gerona passed around an Evaluation Plan for Phase Oversight Committee. There will be quality improvement sessions. Would like to use clickers. Evaluate during Phase 2, not at the end. A course evaluation will be sent in June and a final evaluation at the end of Phase 2. QI can be done at the beginning of small group sessions instead of the end. Special Projects and Communication Engagement II evaluation can be done at end of Phase 2. Clinical Skills evaluation can be done before summer break. With regard to faculty evaluation, maybe evaluate before or after summative exams. ILS Receiving feedback from the students.
