- supervisor (or main advisor) reference letter

Should a scholarship/award require an extra component, it will be listed below under **Application Process** and should be clearly identified as a component of that particular application (for example: *reference letter #2 for Dr. Noreen Golfman Graduate Award*).

Bautista Graduate Bursary in Medicine

Deadline: Wednesday, January 24th, 2024 (apply to rgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility:

This bursary was established by Dr. Michael Bautista MD, FRCPC, and a graduate of Memorial University of Newfoundland's Faculty of Medicine 1981. The bursary will be awarded annually to a **full-time or part-time graduate student in the Faculty of Medicine** on the basis of financial need and academic excellence. To be eligible, students must have **completed at least two semesters of study** in a Master's program. The recipient must have <u>demonstrated financial need as well as meet the minimum academic requirements for a bursary</u> as defined by Memorial University of Newfoundland.

Application Process:

Students must submit a <u>Faculty of Medicine – Scholarship Application Form</u> to the Research & Graduate Studies (RGS) Office, Faculty of Medicine (<u>rgs@mun.ca</u>). Applications should also include (and be clearly identifiable in your application package):
