Dr. Chelsey Blackwood Graduate Scholarship in Fisheries Innovation

Deadline: February 9, 2024 (apply to sgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility: Awarded annually to a **full-time graduate student** a Memorial University in a **research-based program**. Preference will be for students whose research focuses on Innovation in the Seafood Processing and Product Development Industry. If there is no such student, then the secondary preference will be for a student whose research focuses on Innovation in the Fishery more generally. Preference may also be given to a student who has demonstrated financial need. The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for a scholarship.

Application Process: The scholarship application consists of:

- a covering letter that includes linking their research to Innovation in the Seafood Processing, Product Development Industry or to Innovation in the Fishery more generally,
- a one-or-two page research statement,
- a CV,
- two letters of reference, and
- a current academic transcript
