

Competence by Design CBD is here!

Starting on July 1st our new PGY-1's began CBD and require observations through the **MUNCAT app**.

If you haven't done it yet - go to the app store and download the app!! All you need is your MUN login and password to get started!



Our new residents are working on the EPA's in **Transition to Discipline**

EPA1 - Performing and presenting a basic history and physical examination

EPA2 - Documenting orders for pediatric patients

The resident will be entering the information. First, identifiers need to be entered, ie. where you were working, age of the patient etc. Then the work based assessment needs to be documented.

The milestones for each EPA are listed within the app and those observed can be selected. There is a sliding scale that can be used. Narrative comments should also be included.

Remember the tips to help with your narrative comments:

- Justify the ratings
- Have specific examples
- Provide recommendations for improving performance
- Are written in a supportive manner
- Are detailed enough for the Competence Committee to understand the strengths and issues

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Faculty then inputs their PIN and the observation is submitted!!

If you do not have a PIN, please contact the MUNCAT team (muncat@med.mun.ca) for them to email your individualized PIN!!

Remember that our aim is for our residents to achieve these EPAs in 3-4 months, with EPA1 requiring 4 observations and EPA2 requiring 6 observations. In order to achieve this, we are expecting our residents to have at least 2 observations weekly, but the more observations we have, the better.

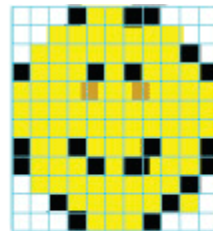
Think of each observation as a pixel– the more we have, the more complete a picture we end up with!
