NON TRADITIONAL - Progression to Post Graduate (P2P)

GENERAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 week integrated Selective – ‘Real Life’, tailored to you placement that will allow you to follow patients in the system. • Longitudinal generalist community based experience. • ONLY available in NL, NB and PEI. • Suggest a site! • First come first serve basis – apply early! • Separate P2P one-pager document with enhanced details.

TRADITIONAL SELECTIVES

GENERAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consists of four weeks each of Surgery, Rural Core and Non-Core.
SURGERY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If choosing consecutive weeks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be completed as one 4 week placement in one subspecialty. • Can be completed as 2 x 2 week back to back placements where the subspecialties chosen can be different. • If choosing nonconsecutive 2 x 2 weeks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The subspecialty chosen does not have to be the same for both placements.
RURAL CORE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 weeks in a rural site: population <50,000 and >1 hour drive from a population of >100,000. • Not able to split rotation – must be consecutive weeks. Must reside in community for the duration of the placement. • If completing as Surgery, Orthopedics or General Surgery must be chosen. • If completing as Surgery, requires at least 8 weeks of Non-Surgery Selectives or Electives.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anesthesia /Emergency Medicine Combination • This is the only approved combination that will satisfy the 4 week Rural Core Selective requirement.
NON-CORE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 different 2 week rotations for Non-Core: 4-weeks in total • NOT Surgical and NOT completed in Core <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If completed in core, cannot complete in post core (as either Adult or Pediatrics). • If not completed in core, can complete in post core but can only complete 1 (either the Adult or Pediatric version). • Non-Core options at other schools are permitted.
