The wages were retained on account of a debt claimed by Morry from Brien Cashin as a partner of William Brodrick. They and John Cashin were in a fishing voyage in 1814, fell into debt at end for £24. Brodrick could not pay his share of the debt. They dissolved their partnership. Since then he has worked for Sweetlands. The case was postponed. [The wording is not clear]
