As a result of the help that you have given me I have compiled a nucleus of the genealogical chart of the Duchemin Family of Newfoundland.

Watson Duchemin came to Charlottetown in 1819 and died in Oct. 10, 1884. I have quite an extensive chart of his family up to the present time. His brother Peter Duchemin and another brother seemed to have settled in Saint John's a little later. Peter opened his block and pump factory on 366 Water St. in 1832 and appears to have remained until just after 1871. I have been unable to find any information about the other brother, not even his name. I have identified all of the names in the directory pages that you sent me except James Duchemin, the blacksmith, res. 1 George St., and Peter Duchemin, the blockmaker of 2 George St. in Saint John's. As James (not James L.) disappears about the time that Peter leaves he may be the brother that I am looking for.

Watson's daughter, Sarah Anne Duchemin married Peter Duchemin her first cousin. Therefore, he may be Peter the blacksmith of 2 George Street who may be the son of Peter sr.

The above I am trying to prove or verify, consequently, if I could find the cemetery, or cemeteries where they may have been buried I might find the date of burial, and through your newspaper files, the obituary, and hopefully, mention of the next of kin. Then through the churches that they attended, I might find the same in baptism and marriage notices.

Now, I ask if you can give me the name of the cemetery, or cemeteries where they may have been buried, and the churches that they would have attended, (They lived on 367 Water St. and 1-5 George Street.) then I will write them for what information that they have. Some cemeteries have a plan or map of the plot layout with the names of the owners inscribed. The church attended may have been Methodist.

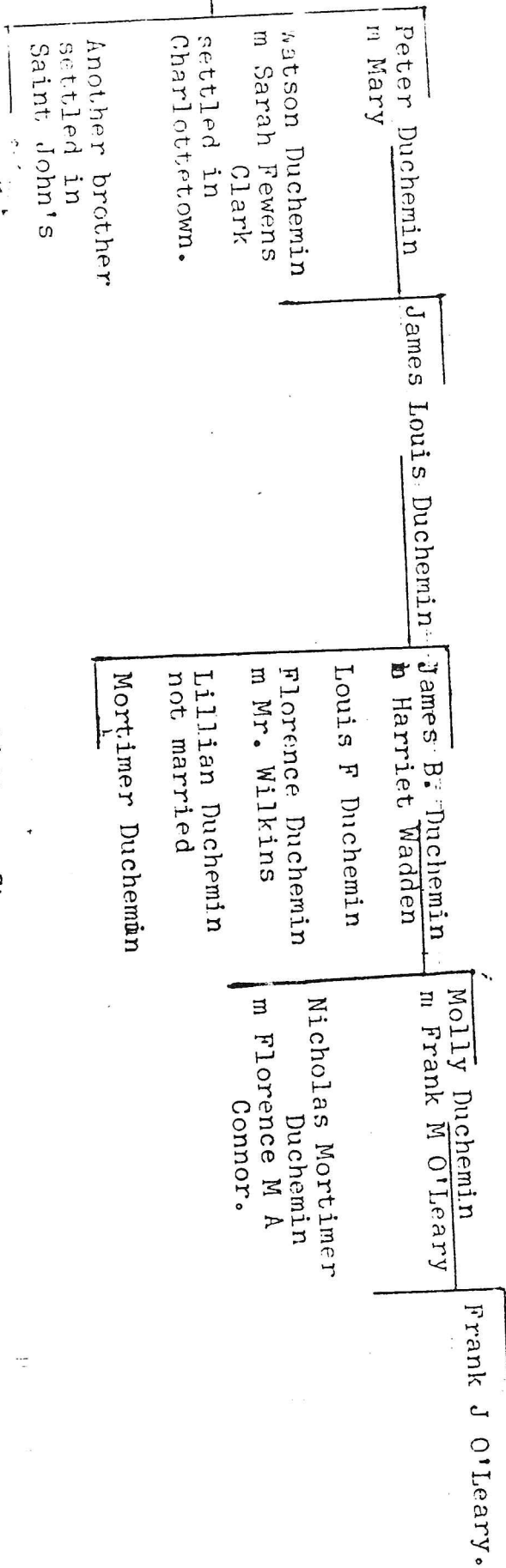

Peter opened a block an pump factory at 366 Water St. in 1832.

His son James Louis helped his father in the factory and at his father's passing became proprietor.

James B. moved to New York in about 1890 with his family.

Louis F was killed in the Spanish American War.

Nothing is known about Mortimer, son of James Louis.

Nicholas Mortimer eventually became Vice President of the General Electric Corporation. He died about 1965.

Molly and Frank M. O'Leary had a son Frank J. O'Leary, a prominent man in St. Johns Newfoundland.
