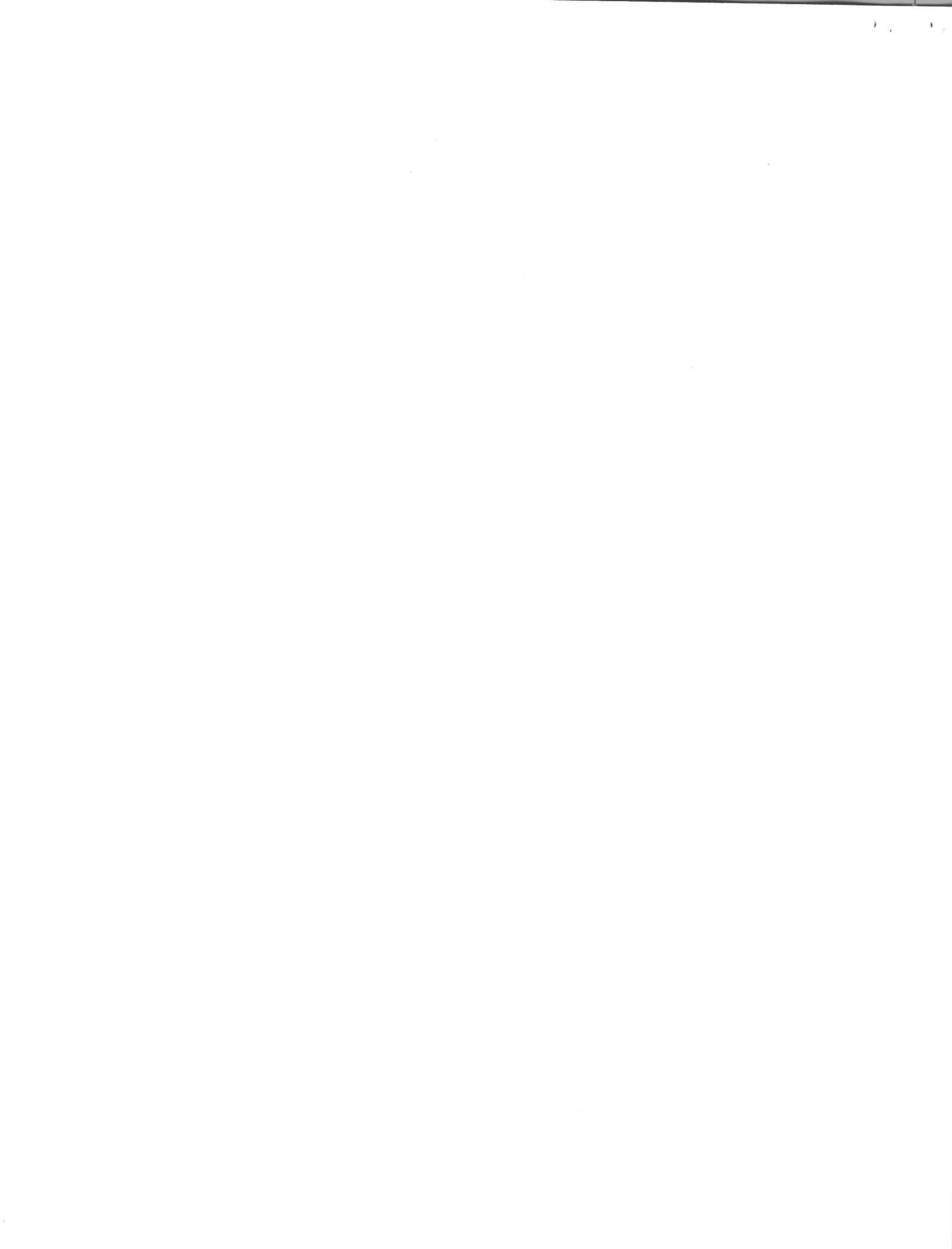

A petition to the Chief Justice by 18 coopers, including James Vavasour and Patrick McCarthy, lately employed by Messrs. Newman - "In consequence of the verdict against our employers in your court of Saturday last, we are thrown out of employment, and we are unable to find any other and see before us nothing but misery and starvation for ourselves and large families. Mr. Hawson has promised to employ us again as soon as he can erect a cooperage in a situation which will not stand contrary to law. We pray that you will take a view of the extensive vacant premises of Messrs. Newman and Company and point out where it will be lawful for them to erect the said cooperage."

A memorial of Newman and Company of St. John's, merchants to Chief Justice Forbes. "have for a great number of years carried on business in this place, occupying very extensive and commodious premises at the western extremity of the town called Riverhead. An old decayed store on the western boundary of our premises built on piles over the water being 85 ft. clear of the nearest house has for the last twenty-five years and upwards being used as a cooperage for trimming and preparing casks for our own use, but when the act of the Geo. 4 Cap. 51 was received in Newfoundland and laid before the Grand Jury to be enforced, our agent, Henry Hawson, being one of the Grand Jury laid before his brother James the situation of the said cooperage, when upon a view that it was not adjoining to or connected with any building on Water Street so as to endanger

their safety according to the interest of the Act, we felt confident that we were not acting illegally in continuing to employ coopers there. And many of the trade being out of employment this summer and had large families depending solely on their labour for subsistence, we from motives of charity gave employment to six who had wives and twenty-six children. These are, with 12 other coopers, thrown out of employment in consequence of the verdict against human royalists in the honourable court of Saturday last. We pray the consideration of the court as well as to the circumstances of our having voluntarily pulled down and removed at considerable expense another cooperage which evidently came within the meaning of the act.

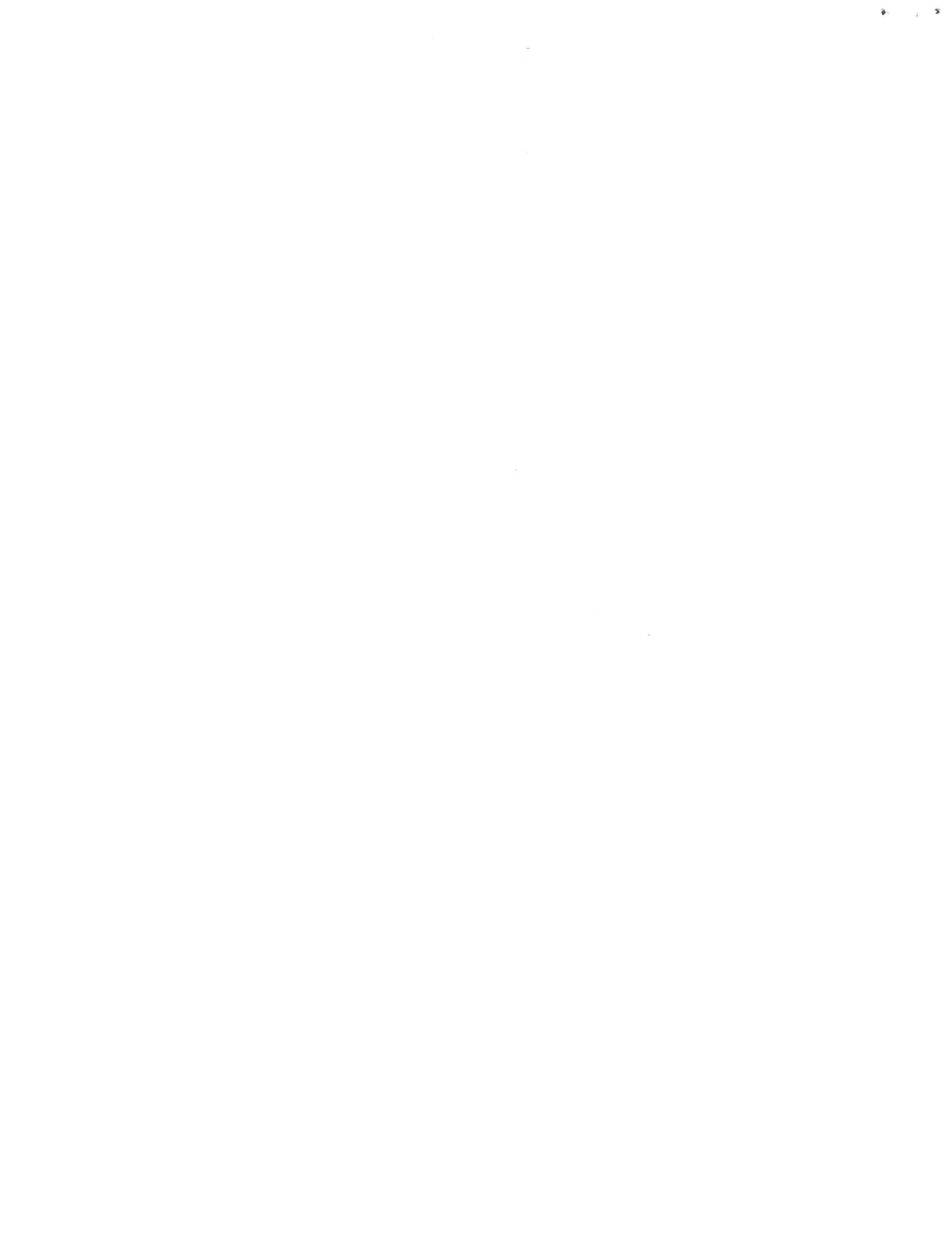

Judgment delivered by Mr. Justice HAYWARD.

This case was tried before Mr. Justice Robinson and myself without a Jury, and the action was taken to decide the right of the parties to a piece of Waterside property in the East part of the Town of St. John's.

The Plaintiffs possess property to the West of that of the Defendant, and the contention in this case was that the latter had encroached about 15 feet on the former's Eastern boundary.

In support of the Plaintiffs' case, evidence was given that Robert Newman was the original proprietor of the property at present owned by Plaintiffs, and a plan in an ancient Government Record book, dated 1763, was produced in evidence, marked in the name of Robert Newman and one Honora Woollicott, and the extent of property, which by that plan appeared to have belonged to them, was 219 feet from East to West. It appeared also that the properties were incorporated into one by the purchase by Plaintiffs of the interest of Woollicott's representatives.

Mr. Thomas G Morey who was Agent for the Messrs. Newman from 1827 to 1865, stated in his evidence that their property in the locality in question, when he became Agent, was occupied by Mr. Matthew Warren and that he received the rents at that time, but that he did not then know the boundaries.

That in 1848, he knew the boundaries by having measured the extent of the property, taking for his guide the plan in the old Record Book, a copy of which he found amongst Newman's papers. That he commenced the measurement on the West from a slit in a rock, which was the Western boundary mark, and measured East 219 feet, and that the present erections of the Defendant, which are complained of in this action, cover 15 or 16 feet on the East of that measurement, but that they had no Eastern boundary mark.

That Woollicott then had a house on this property, and that there were 20 feet between it and Defendant's land, on which space the trespass in question was committed. This house went to decay, or was torn down, and no evidence could be produced to point out the spot on the land where it was situated.

The witness also stated that 8 or 4 years before the present Store of Defendant was erected, he saw on the property an iron boundary mark, which had been placed there since he ceased the Agency, which marked the correct boundary, and the Store extended 15 or 16 feet to the West of that mark, which it covered.

That about the year 1846, the Defendant, who then occupied the adjoining land East,

workshop he says he occupied on that site for 12 or 13 years and continued to occupy the land ever since, and was never interfered with in its possession.

That he excavated under this building to the extent of about 38 feet, and deep enough for a man to stand in, and his reason for not excavating to the full extent of 40 feet, was because he built no wall.

That as far down as the water he occupied during the whole of this time in building vessels and with timber, boats, &c., deposited there—that he built 7 or 8 vessels there from 100 to 180 tons each, with 20 or 25 feet beam, and possessed and occupied the land until the present day, and once during the time built two Vessels side by side, of 180 and 150 tons.

That about a foot or six inches west of the old workshop, there was formerly a granite stone, which was considered the boundary stone of his present premises separating it from Roberts, and that his present erection does not extend to it by about two feet, but is on the land occupied by him since 1848.

He further stated that he never agreed to pay rent to Plaintiffs for the property in question as alleged by Mr. Morey, but that he had an agreement about using a place on the Plaintiff's property about 200 feet distant, where there were large stones, and therefore convenient for hauling up large spars.

In his cross examination the Defendant stated that about two years ago when the boundaries of the property were disputed, he erected a fence on a line where the Clerk of Plaintiff's Agent and Mr. Maher Land Surveyor for them, had measured as the Plaintiff's boundary, this was 15 feet on his property but that he did so only as a temporary convenience until the dispute between them should be settled.

In support of this evidence Defendant called two witnesses, the first of whom was Lewis Rutledge who stated that he lived near the premises and knew them 50 years, that he remembered the workshop that Defendant had there, which was 40 or 41 feet in length and is now standing on other ground adjacent; that the present building does not occupy as much land as the workshop did; that the gateway on the East of Defendant's premises is now just as it was in 1846; that there was a boundary stone 50 years ago on the land a little further West than Defendants erection and that the Defendant occupied the property after the removal of the workshop, he had boats lumber and bank on it, built vessels there and upon one occasion built two vessels abreast.

There is a great discrepancy upon one point between the evidence of the Defendant and this witness as to the time of the removal of the workshop; the former stating that it was done about the year 1860 and the latter that it was before 1851.

The other witness, Thomas Osborne, proved that he lived on the property in possession of the Defendant 88 years ago with his father, who occupied part of a house of two tenements; that William Newman, under whom Defendant claims title, was their landlord to whom they paid rent; that their house was North of Defendant's present building, and extended 8 or 9 feet further West; that they occupied the land between the house and the water; that their waterside was about 45 feet and that persons who used to haul up boats there would always ask his father's permission before doing so and that the gateway on the Eastern boundary was the same 40 years ago as it now is.
