EARLY PIKE REFERENCE.

JOHN

- 1708/9 JOHN a Planter at Carbonear. Signs petition concerning French attacks. (Reference C.O.194).
- 1720 JOHN Commander of the BROMSGROVE of Poole takes a cargo of wheat from Poole to Oporto (reference Port books).

SAMUEL

- 1721 Commander of the MARY of Poole in the Newfoundland trade owned apparently by Thomas Nickelson. (Reference Port books).

HENRY

- 1675 of Poole, commander of the HENRY, a small coastal and north European trader. Voyage to Croisic in France (reference Port books).

EDWARD

- 1687 of Poole commander of the ELIZABETH, 100 tons 14 men, voyage unknown at present. (reference Adm.7/76).

WILLIAM

- 1662 a Dissenter in Poole (Reference Sydenham).
- 1673 With Edward Mann and John Carter owners of the CHARLES. Voyage from Newfoundland to Malaga - taken by Sallee Rovers (reference Acts Privy Council Co.1.)
- 1677 (Junior?) commander of the Elizabeth (see Edward) . Voyage from Poole to Newfoundland. (Reference Pepys.Mas.)
- 1683 Commander of the same vessel (Ref. Adm.7/75).
- 1684 Commander of the same, a sack ship at Old Perlican. Took fish to Naples (References C.O.1/55 and Adm.7/76).
1685. Commander of the same

- 1688 William, Senior on Poole Municipal Corporation (Ref. Sydenham).
- 1692 William, now an Anglican (Ref. Sydenham).
- 1693 William, Mayor of Poole.

- 1699 William (Junior?) Commander of the JOHN & SAMUEL of Poole, 150 tons, 25 men and 4 boats. At Bonavista. Goes on to Virginia in Ballast (Ref. C.O. 194/1)

- William (Junior?) commander of the JOHN & SAMUEL (above). Voyage from Poole to Virginia for John Masters (Ref. Port Books).

HARBOUR GRACE SURROGATE COURT RECORDS 1823 - 1824

Nicholas Ash by his wife Patience versus John Alcock, grandson to the late John Ash, senior, deceased, complaining that the defendent would not give up a small plot of meadow on the north boundary, the west side of the lake, John Ash's room. The court surveyed the ground. Widow Ash said that she had always cut the grass of the said spot of room for a considerable number of years and that the Plaintiff might clear as much ground ti the westward if a new erection then built by John Snow (Blathes son) in lieu of the land in dispute and be considered the said Nicholas Ash' property during his excellency's pleasure

CONCEPTION BAY PLANTATION BOOK 1804

Francis Pike owned a stage, 2 flakes, a beach, 5 houses, 4 gardens and a meadow in Carbonear, bequeathed by his fathers will in 1783. It had been in the family for 56 years (1804). Francis brothers were Edward and Samuel.

NORTH CIRCULAR COURT 1828 4th June

Francis sued James Walsh over house and land in Carbonear. (This was either Francis above or the son of) His grandfather was the Pike of Pike and Green, merchants of Poole and Newfoundland in the 1750,s.
