Dated September, a memorial of William Thomas and Henry Phillips Thomas. They have resided in this town about 22 years and have never received any lease or grant of land, they now ask for 50 acres each on the White Down. We are large agriculturalists and we bring into use the best method of English husbandry which must be of essential benefit to the inhabitants of the island generally and in this town particular, -Since this must enable people to procure the necessaries of life much cheaper than they could before, and prevent their being left in the winter in a state approaching starvation. Without large farms this cannot be accomplished because of the heavy expenses necessary to make a farm productive. The dwelling house, barn, good stable and completely frost proof cellar on a large scale are necessary. Many of our small farms neglect to cultivate or even to fence them because they are too small to pay them for the trouble. We have a capital of about £2200. embarked in our farming speculations without having one acre of ground to call our own. We have to pay £200. a year in cash (bills) equal to £230. cash for a farm of one hundred acres - only 60 or 70 of which are in cultivation. From the difference in the rents between the newly granted farms and the one in which we are, it is impossible to compete with the new grantees. We have at present a government contract to supply fresh beef, but we need a spot of ground to feed our cattle on in place of having to pay so heavy a rent. We also like to draw attention to the possibility of giving employment to the excess of the population, especially to the women and children. The men who are employed on the farms here, especially in potato-growing before the fishery starts, and they dig them up after it is ended while the women and children are employed throughout the season doing the lighter work of the farm.
