

# Information and FAQs

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## How is [Instrumental Music Week \(IMW\)](#) different from [Junior Band Week \(JBW\)](#)?

IMW is for high school musicians – ages 15–19, or entering grades 10, 11, or 12 in the upcoming school year or having just graduated high school. If your student participated in JBW in the past but has now aged out, this experience is for them!

## How much musical experience do students need?

Students should have previous ensemble performance experience, usually a minimum of two years. If you have less experience than this, email Dr. Dylan Maddix ([dmaddix@mun.ca](mailto:dmaddix@mun.ca)) and Dr. Michelle Cheramy ([mcheramy@mun.ca](mailto:mcheramy@mun.ca)) and they will assess your readiness for IMW.

## Does IMW registration sell out?

No, but we do have limited space. Registrations may be considered after Monday, July 22. Email [music@mun.ca](mailto:music@mun.ca) to inquire.

## What is the refund policy?

Prior to Friday, July 31, 2026, a refund of the full fee, less a \$20 administrative fee, will be granted. Email [music@mun.ca](mailto:music@mun.ca) to request a refund. No refunds at all will be granted after Friday, July 31, 2026.

## Where do IMW activities take place?

All IMW activities are held inside/near the MUN School of Music (M.O. Morgan Building).

## What activities happen during IMW?

Students participate in a variety of ensemble experiences, including Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, and chamber music. They also receive instrument-specific instruction from School of Music faculty and expert community musicians.

## Do students provide their own instruments?

Yes, all students must provide their own instruments. In addition to instruments, students should bring IMW music, a notepad, and a pencil, plus the following instrument-specific gear:

- **Flute:** cleaning rod, soft non-linting cloth
- **Oboe:** all reeds in a reed case, cork grease, swab
- **Clarinet:** box of reeds, cork grease, swab
- **Saxophone:** box of reeds, cork grease, swab
- **Trumpet, Euphonium, Tuba:** valve oil
- **Trombone:** slide oil
- **Percussion:** sticks, practice pad (no other instruments required)

## Will my student be required to bring a snack and packed lunch?

Yes, students should bring snacks, lunches, and a water bottle every day. There are no refrigeration facilities at IMW, so you may choose to use icepacks in your students' lunches. *Please note that IMW is a peanut-free environment.*

## What are the drop-off and pick-up times?

Morning drop-off is 8:30-9:00am. Students check in first thing each morning. Activities begin at 9:00am. Afternoon pick-up is 4:00pm.

## What type of clothing does my student need to bring?

Comfortable clothing and footwear are ideal (t-shirt, shorts, sneakers, etc.). Our building can get very hot in the summer. We allow students to enjoy time outside each day, so please make sure your student has appropriate clothing for that day's weather forecast.

## What if my student needs medication?
