# CANADIAN WOMEN'S FOUNDATION

- The Canadian Women's Foundation is dedicated to long-term systemic change that will bring about the equality of women and girls in Canada.
- They grant funds for innovative and diverse programs and projects designed to help women and girls achieve greater self-reliance and economic independence.
- They fund only programs and projects that take place in Canada. Most grants are for a one-year period. The maximum grant size is between \$15,000 and \$25,000, depending on which Fund the grants are made from. Larger, multi-year grants are sometimes made through special collaborative funds.
- Because CWF is a registered charitable foundation, by law, they are only permitted to give grants to organizations which are charities registered with Canada Customs and Revenue.

# HEALTH CANADA

Newfoundland & Labrador Centre for Applied Health Research

- The Bureau of Women's Health and Gender Analysis of Health Canada has initiatives such as the Women's Health Indicators Project
- Also, there is the Women's Health Contribution Program which contributes approximately \$2.95 million annually to eligible recipients. It currently supports:
  - Centres of Excellence for Women's Health
  - the Canadian Women's Health Network
  - Working groups and other initiatives that address specific policy issues in women's health



# STATUS OF WOMEN CANADA

Newfoundland & Labrador Centre for Applied Health Research

- Provides financial and technical assistance to support action by women's organizations and other partners seeking to advance equality for women by addressing women's economic, social, political and legal situation.
- Policy Research Fund for:
  - research that identifies policy gaps, trends and emerging issues;
  - research that examines the consequences of existing policies; and,
  - research that focuses on concrete recommendations for policies and practices that would improve the status of women.
