Sites of Study

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) (Collaborative) program is offered at three locations:

This September, 2022, the Faculty of Nursing will also offer the BScN program at three satellite sites in:

- **Happy Valley-Goose Bay**
- **Gander**
- **Grand Falls-Windsor**

Which site is best for you?

While the curriculum is the same at all sites, you may wish to consider factors such as the availability and cost of residence and transportation costs when making your decision.

Students in St. John's and Corner Brook sites have access to computer and library facilities, recreational activities, health care, and counselling services. Access to library facilities and counselling services at Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Gander and Grand Falls-Windsor will be through remote access to Memorial University.

You will indicate your site preferences on your application form for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) (Collaborative) program and you can rank your top three preferences.

1) Where will my classes take place?

Lectures will be delivered synchronously, on-site and remote, depending on the course. On-site courses will be delivered in the community of your program, Gander, Grand Falls-Windsor or Happy Valley-Goose Bay. Most lectures are not pre-recorded, but offered in real-time (synchronous) and you'll be able to interact with the lecturer.

2) Where will my labs and clinical courses take place?

Your labs will be delivered on site and in-person in the community of your program, Gander, Grand Falls-Windsor or Happy Valley-Goose Bay. Your clinical courses will also be offered in-person through supervision of a clinical instructor at a health care facility in your region. There may be an occasion where clinical placements for certain specialties will be held at another location and travel may be required.

3) I'm wondering about places to live in Gander/Grand-Falls-Windsor/Happy Valley-Goose Bay. Does Memorial have any residences/apartments in these areas?

Memorial University doesn't have residences or housing at these locations, but private accommodations are available. Please see below for community-specific housing resources.
