The Department of Psychology invites applications from individuals interested in teaching **PSYC 6612 Adult Psychopathology**, in the fall semester, 2024.

Subject to budgetary restrictions and sufficient enrolments, appointments will be made on a course-by-course basis and will not entail any obligation to conduct research or to perform any administrative service for Memorial University. Appointments will be made in accordance with the provisions in the MUN-LUMUN Collective Agreement. Course design and evaluation methods for all courses will be in accordance with Faculty of Science and Dept. of Psychology regulations, as well as the Memorial University Calendar.

**Course Title:** PSYC 6612 Adult Psychopathology

**Course Schedule:** will be determined by the PsyD Program Director in consultation with the instructor.

**Campus Location:** St. John's Campus, In Person

**Course Description:** The main objective of this course is to review theory and research concerning adult psychological disorders from a biopsychosocial perspective. Students are expected to develop a strong understanding of common diagnostic categories including anxiety disorders, mood disorders, eating disorders, substance use disorders, trauma and stressor-related disorders, somatic symptom disorders, sleep disorders, psychotic disorders and personality disorders, with a focus on the DSM-5-TR system of classification. Issues related to comorbidities and differential diagnosis will also be discussed. Students will learn cognitive-behavioural (and other evidence-based) conceptualizations of various mental health disorders. Students will be encouraged to think critically about adult psychopathology including such topics as culture, race, gender, stigma, discrimination, and social justice. **Qualifications:** (1) A doctorate (PhD or PsyD) from a CPA- or APA-accredited clinical psychology program, (2) successful completion of a CPA- or APA- accredited pre-doctoral internship in clinical psychology, (3) either registered or provisionally registered with the Newfoundland and Labrador Psychology Board or another provincial regulator, (4) demonstrated knowledge of the specific topics noted in the course description above.
