**Course Title:** PSYC 6670 Interprofessional Education

**Course Description: PSYC 6670 Interprofessional Education** covers the dynamics of working in evidence-based interprofessional collaborative practice. Over the first three years of their program of study, PsyD learners participate in interprofessional education activities (typically one per semester) together with learners from medicine, nursing, pharmacy, social work, kinesiology, and recreational therapy programs to learn with, from and about each other to provide care services more efficiently and effectively in a wide variety of practice settings. Topics covered include team functioning, communication, conflict management, quality improvement, relationship-centred care, community mental health, primary care, child welfare, or other special topics. The successful applicant will facilitate all eleven small interprofessional group learning activities in the fall and winter semesters following curriculum programming coordinated through the Centre for Collaborative Health Professional Education (CCHPE; visit <https://www.mun.ca/medicine/research/research-centres/cchpe/> for more details). Additionally, the successful applicant will be responsible for assessing learners' assigned work and leading debriefs with PsyD learners following each interprofessional education activity.
