Course Title: PSYC 7035, Practicum in Rural Intervention and Interprofessional Practice

Course Description: Psychology 7035 Practicum in Rural Intervention and Interprofessional Practice provides supervised training in an approved clinical setting, with an emphasis on the development of advanced assessment and intervention skills, including working collaboratively with other healthcare professionals and in rural settings when possible. The practicum requires that students spend 30 hours per week for 6 weeks working under supervision in an approved setting and participate in a weekly seminar.
