Teaching Term Appointment

The Department of Psychology at Memorial University of Newfoundland invites applications for a nine-month Teaching Term position at the rank of Assistant Professor for the Fall 2023 and Winter 2024 semesters. Teaching requirements include both Introductory Psychology and Social psychology courses. The appointment will not entail any obligation to conduct research or perform any administrative service for Memorial University.

The successful candidate should have a doctorate degree in psychology, or nearing completion of a doctorate degree in psychology. Previous teaching in a university setting would be an asset.

Applicants should submit (1) a cover letter summarizing their interest in the position; 2) a curriculum vitae; (3) a statement of their teaching philosophy and evidence of teaching effectiveness; and (4) names, email and mailing addresses of 3 referees to:
