

Professional Associate of the Department of Psychology

The Professional Associate appointment enables formal academic relationships with the University falling outside the normal categories of university teachers as described in the Collective Agreement with the Faculty Association. Additional information about the Professional Associate appointments can be located on the website of the Office of the Provost and Vice-President (Academic) (<https://www.mun.ca/vpacademic/academic-recruitment/appointments/>).

Professional Associates will participate in activities of a unit so as to contribute to the professional development of faculty members and students of the academic unit to which the appointment is recommended. Professional Associates may not supervise or co-supervise graduate students but may serve on supervisory committees.

Appointments will be for a fixed period not to exceed three years and are renewable.

Considerations for initial adjudication:

- 1) A registered Psychologist in good standing with the board;
- 2) 2 years post registration (provisional registration contributes towards this 2-year timeline).
- 3) Track record of having successfully supervised a minimum of 2 PsyD student practicum experiences; ***or*** a strong recommendation from the clinical group for service rendered (e.g., time served as Professional Practice Co-coordinator for the health authority, teaching and supervision within PsyD curriculum).

Considerations for renewal of 3-year term:

- 1) Current registration as a professional Psychologist;
- 2) Continued evidence of supervision of PsyD students (i.e., at least one PsyD student practicum experience during the previous 3-year timeframe); ***or*** service rendered to the PsyD program.
