

SCHEDULE:

- **December 2, 2019 (or sooner):** Application and \$50 registration fee due (reimbursed to unsuccessful applicants). Please submit your application & deposit to Ms. Annette Sullivan in the departmental office, A5007 (8:30am-4:00pm).
- **December 6, 2019:** Students contacted about the status of their application (if they have a spot or are on the waitlist).
- **January 31, 2020:** Non-refundable \$600 program fee payment due; where no deposit is received, spots will be offered to waitlisted students.
- **March 15, 2020:** Balance of payment due for program fee (\$500, for a total program fee of \$1150).
- **March 25, 2020:** Online registration for the two courses.
- **June 1, 2020:** Students must provide evidence of health insurance, student visa (if necessary), and passport.
- **June 2020 (date TBD):** Course and travel orientation @ MUN.
- **July 1-31, 2020:** France field school.

OTHER INFO

- Program fee (total of \$1150) includes venue fees, on-campus accommodation at the University of Bordeaux, at hotel in Lourdes and in Paris, all course excursions and field trips.
- Students are responsible for other costs, including passport (and student visa, if necessary), airfare, meals, travel health insurance, and any travel extraneous to the course.
- There are grants available for student travel; once we have a list of students attending in January, I will facilitate a meeting for those interested in fundraising.
