

Ethics Scenario # 1

Full disclosure of investigations to participants

A volunteer employee has offered to be part of one of the Ergo-Team's interventions. This individual approaches an Ergo-Team investigator with one hour remaining in the workday. The investigator is excited and would like to start the project right away.

BUT: there is not enough time left in the workday to complete the consent form, explain the volunteer's involvement, and start the project.

The investigator decides to start video recording the volunteer's work on the understanding that the volunteer can complete the consent form and interview during the following workday.

Should the investigator be allowed to proceed? Why?
