

## Social Representative

This position is usually accompanied by a social committee made up of fellow classmates who are willing to help organize such activities.

- Attend regular meetings of the ASWS committee.
- Exercise voting privileges on the ASWS committee.
- Introduce yourself to the student body
- Identify student/ASWS concerns - via **appropriate** communication mediums (ex e-mail, class presentations, student newsletters, facebook, signs in student lounge etc).
- Liaise and bridge connections between social work students and the ASWS committee
- Assist the ASWS committee with the formation a social committee
- Attend and chair regular meetings of the social committee
- Organizing social events for the class
- Coordinating social activities such as fund-raisers and social gatherings.
- Report to the ASWS committee concerning social activities
- Uphold confidentiality at all times unless otherwise directed.
- Other duties as arise and are appropriate

**Social Committee** The social committee is made up of three to six members appointed by the ASWS committee from a pool of volunteers of the graduating year.

Duties include

- Attend regular social committee meetings
- Report to the social representative any information pertaining to social activities
- Assist the grad committee with fundraising as needed
- Plan and execute social activities to engage classmates of graduating year
- Identify student/ASWS concerns - via appropriate communication mediums (ex e-mail, class presentations, student newsletters, facebook, signs in student lounge etc).

- Other duties as arise and are appropriate
