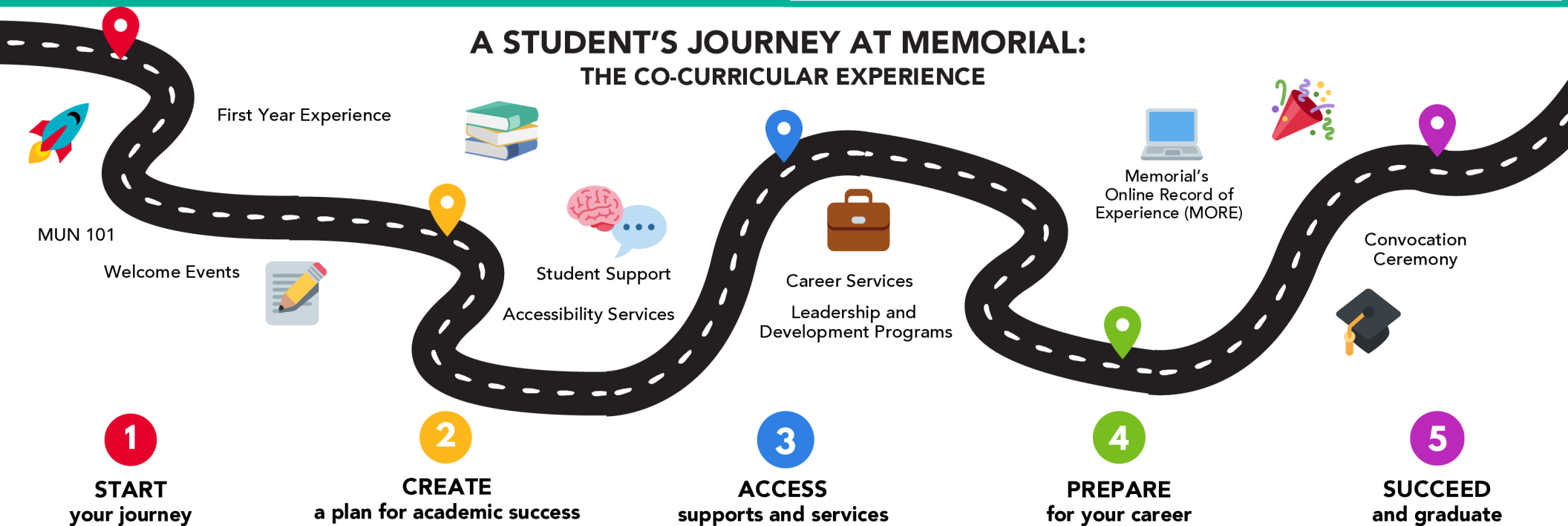
DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE
