SET UP MY.MUN LOGIN

MUN login is your gateway to access Memorial's online services like email, Self-Service, Brightspace (Memorial University's learning management system) and more. Make sure to **set up your MUN login** as soon as possible and be sure to check your @mun email on a regular basis.

STUDENT HOUSING

If you have not already applied for student housing and you hope to live on campus, you should apply for housing as soon as possible.

■ FALL COURSE OFFERINGS

Course offering for the fall semester will be available to view on Memorial Self Service mid to late June. Please review the course offerings and contact your advisor if there are any concerns.

COURSE REGISTRATION

Be sure to learn how to register for courses. Registration for fall courses takes place in July. Students are assigned a specific registration time, and it is important to register as close to your assigned time as possible. Your registration time will be emailed to you at your @mun email address.

MATH PLACEMENT TEST (MPT)

The MPT will be administered in June and September. Any student wishing to do Math

1090 or 1000 will be required to write the MPT. Students who wish to write the MPT in June will need to register before the registration deadline. Students who are unable to write the MPT in June will need to register for the MPT when you register for your courses in July and then write it in September. Please note that calculators are not permitted during the MPT.

CALCULUS PLACEMENT TEST (CPT)

NL students who are completing Math 3208 (Calculus) in high school may wish to write the CPT. Registration for the June offering of the CPT will be available March 15-April 30. Students who are unable to write the CPT in June will need to register for the September offering when you register for courses in July.

SCIENCE 1807 & 1808

Laboratory science courses and some Fine Arts courses may require Science 1807 (Safety in Science Laboratory) and Science 1808 (WHMIS), online safety training courses, as prerequisites. You must register for these courses before you can register for your lab science or Fine Arts course(s). These non-credit courses must be successfully by the end of the first two weeks of September and can be accessed through Brightspace. Any questions can be directed to labsafety@mun.ca.

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

Integrity 1000 is a required non-credit course which you will automatically be registered for after you register for your first-semester courses. The course will be available in your list of courses in Brightspace. You can start INTG 1000 after registering for courses and you must pass this course before you can register for your next semester.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE AWARENESS & PREVENTION

Sexual Violence Awareness and Prevention

(SVM 0204) is a required non-credit course that must be completed by all new undergraduate students. You will automatically be registered for the course. The course will be available in your list of courses in **Brightspace**. You must pass this course before you can register for the next semester.

YOUR GRENFELL EXPERIENCE

This is an online orientation and transition program to help new students adjust to university and prepare you for academic success. You will automatically be enrolled in this course and you will find it on your **Brightspace**. Students can work through this course from July -August.

ACADEMIC BRIDGING

Students graduating from high school with a final admission average between 65 and 69.9% may be eligible to participate in a new **Academic Bridging Program** that will begin in person in late August. Successful participation in this program will result in admission to Memorial University.

PREP WEEK

All new students are invited to attend our university preparation week from August 28 – September 2. It will be a full week of getting ready for a successful start to your first year of university – stay tuned for more details.

WELCOME EVENTS

A variety of **on-campus orientation** events will be planned starting in late August and into September. As the semester gets closer event details will be added so be sure to check it out for event details.
