Description of Organization

SWAP is a harm reduction based service which provides HIV/HCV & STBBI prevention education, along with safer using information, used equipment disposal, and new supplies for people who use drugs.

Volunteer Activities/Duties

SWAP Volunteer (Mon-Fri in office)

- Assemble supplies
- Track incoming orders
- Fill orders for mail outs and delivery
- Provide services to clients

SWAP Volunteer (Tue & Thur nights on outreach van)

- Record and fill orders for delivery
- Track and follow up on telephone orders
- Assist with supply distribution on outreach van
- Drive outreach van during delivery hours

Length of Screening Process

Complete an application at <http://www.acnl.net> or in person. Screening and informal interview involved

Orientation/Training

Orientation will either include group or one-on-one training. Organization and program overview and naloxone training.

Minimum Commitment

Office volunteer: Minimum 3-6 hrs per month or as often as the volunteer would like.

Van volunteer: 4-8 hrs per month. 6 month commitment for both.

Requirements

Certificate of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector Check. Valid Driver's License and copy of insurance are required for outreach van shifts. Volunteers must be 18+ (25+ for drivers), open minded, non-judgemental, and supportive of the harm reduction philosophy.

Other Information

Volunteers may choose either volunteer position or both.
